## Share Your Feedback: Quality Assurance for Micro-Credentials in Ontario

Deadline: Monday, September 25, 2023

The Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board (PEQAB) is currently soliciting feedback regarding the development of a quality assurance framework for micro-credentials in Ontario, which will result in a recommendation to the Minister of Colleges and Universities this fall. We invite all interested COED members to share their feedback on the proposed framework by completing the [PEQAB's Ontario Micro-Credentials Quality Framework Feedback Form](#) before September 25, 2023. COED will then consolidate responses and submit a written response to PEQAB on behalf of our group.
